Pebbles currently supports over 1450 children aged 0 - 25 years through education programmes and health, nutrition and protection services.

Beneficiary profile:

Pebbles works predominantly with agricultural communities, specifically with children of farmworkers on wine, citrus, fruit and rooibos tea farms.

Budget and employees:

Pebbles has an annual budget of R33m and employs 100 staff members.

Pebbles Programmes and Services

Pebbles Project aims to enable children and young adults from agricultural communities to reach their full potential at each appropriate educational phase to ultimately enable them to become participating and responsible members of society.

To achieve this aim, Pebbles provides the following programmes, services and initiatives:

- **Maternal Health Education** for pregnant women to ensure healthy pregnancies
- **First Thousand Days (FTD)** programme for children aged 0 - 2 years
- **Early Childhood Development (ECD)** programme for children aged 3 - 5 years
- **Mobile Resource Centre** support for children with special needs
- **School Enrichment** programme for learners aged 6 - 18, including homework, computer literacy, sport, art, life skills, library and vegetable gardening and a fleet of 6 mobile learning centres
- **Early Adulthood** programme for learners aged 15 - 25 who are unable to complete formal schooling or need support with skills development, further training and job placement
- **Pebbles Academy:** a community primary school for learners in Grade R to Grade 7
- **Health, Wellness and Dental** services and a mobile health clinic
- **Nutrition** service for children attending Pebbles ECD centres and After-School Clubs, with meals prepared in our own food production kitchen
- **Social Work Protection** service for children at risk
